GOT A BITE?

Oskarshamn Municipality is surrounded by exciting fishing waters. Pike, salmon trout and perch can be fished along the Baltic coast for much of the year. The forest landscape of Småland offers lots of lakes with everything from put-and-take waters with rainbow trout to idyllic forest lakes with a fantastic variety of fish species, including pike, perch, salmon, pike-perch and more. Part of River Emån also runs through the area and is world famous for its large salmon trout that regularly appear in international weight records.

In this fishing guide, we provide suggestions on the best fishing waters for your desired catch. We also guide you to places where you can buy fishing gear and permits. We want you to have a wonderful nature-filled experience, whether you're fishing along the coast or by a lake.

FISHING WATERS

THE BALTIC SEA (1)

Experience fishing along Oskarshamn's coastline. We have a beautiful archipelago with lots of great fishing possibilities. In the Baltic Sea, the law on free fishing with hand-held gear applies.

This law allows free fishing in private waters with hand-held gear.

Fish species that thrive in the Baltic Sea are pike, perch, cod, herring, salmon, salmon trout, lavaret and different types of whitefish.

LAKE BOARUMEGÖL (2)

Discover beautiful lake fishing at Kristdala. There are pike, perch, pike-perch and crayfish here. **A fishing permit is required to fish in the lake.**

RIVER EMÅN (3) (only parts of Emån)

Welcome to fish in Småland's largest river. Fishermen from all over the world come here to catch salmon, salmon trout, chub, pike, perch and lavaret. You need a fishing permit to fish in River Emån. Given its length, you can also fish in the river in our neighbouring municipalities of Högsby and Mönsterås. **A fishing permit is required to fish in the river.**



LAKE HUMMELN (4)

Try your luck fishing in Kristdala by Lake Hummeln, which is in a meteor crater. This is a lake with very high water quality. Fish that thrive here are pike, perch, burbot and different types of whitefish. **A fishing permit is required to fish in the lake.**

RIVER MARSTRÖMMEN (5)

Marströmmen, a flowing river with connected lakes, can be found in the very northernmost parts of Oskarshamn. Sea trout, pike, perch and burbot thrive here. **A fishing permit is required to fish.**

THE HÄLLESJÖN LAKES (6)

(Stora and Lilla)

Would you like to catch a nice rainbow trout? Then we recommend a visit to the Hällesjön lakes. Here you'll find lake

fishing with put-and-take waters. Put-and-take is the introduction of game fish for game fishing purposes in waters where these species cannot normally reproduce. At Lake Stora Hällesjön, boats are available to use free of charge through Fliseryds Sportfiskeklubb (game fishing club). At Lake Lilla Hällesjön, only fly-fishing from land is permitted. **A fishing permit is required to fish in each of the lakes.**

QUARRY FLY-FISHING (7)

Fishing in a quarry! You'll find exclusive Catch & Release fly-fishing in two quarries outside Misterhult. Here you can fish for salmon trout and rainbow trout. On site there is access to a guide and boat. **You must book on the stenbrottetflyfishing.com website to fish here.**



The quarries offer exclusive Catch & Release fly fishing with the opportunity to catch both rainbow trout and salmon trout.

THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

- Always find out which rules and laws apply where you want to fish.
- Take your rubbish home, including lines and hooks.
- Don't disturb plant and animal life.
- Keep your distance to residential homes, the right of public access does not apply within the immediate vicinity of a residence (hemfridszon).
- The right of public access does not apply to arable land or other land that can be damaged, such as plantations.
- If you travel on water, show consideration by not disturbing the surroundings by causing unnecessary noise or big waves.
- Camping in a tent for a single day is allowed under the right of public access, but camping for several days or in a group with several tents requires permission from the landowner.

FISHING RULES FOR THE COAST

FISHING IS PERMITTED WITH HAND-HELD GEAR by Swedish and foreign citizens on the coast in public and private waters. Hand-held gear refers to fishing with a rod.

TROLLING in private waters is prohibited without the permission of the owner of the fishing rights.

MINIMUM CATCH SIZE along the coast: salmon 60 cm, salmon trout 50 cm, pike 40 cm and pike-perch 40 cm.

LIMITS ON PIKE CATCHES apply along the entire east coast: max three per fisherman per day measuring 40–75 cm.

FISHING FOR SALMON AND SALMON TROUT in waters that open into the Baltic Sea is prohibited from 1/10 to 31/12. Observe protected zones in estuary areas. svenskafiskeregler.se

FISH CAUGHT DURING THE CLOSED SEASON or that do not meet minimum size requirements must be released immediately.

FISHING WITH HAND-HELD GEAR may not take place closer than 100 m from fixed commercial fishing gear or fish farms.

AS AN ANGLER, IT IS ILLEGAL to sell fish caught from the sea.

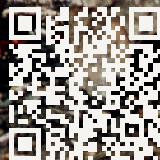
RESPECT AND LOOK AFTER NATURE!

To protect the fish stocks in our waters, many anglers today apply Catch & Release. This means putting the fish back into the water, provided it is unharmed. This builds up the stock of viable fish.

Everyone has a responsibility to comply with the applicable fishing rules and restrictions and to purchase a valid fishing permit. Even if fishing is not included in the right of public access, you can fish freely with a rod and certain other hand-held gear along the coasts.
